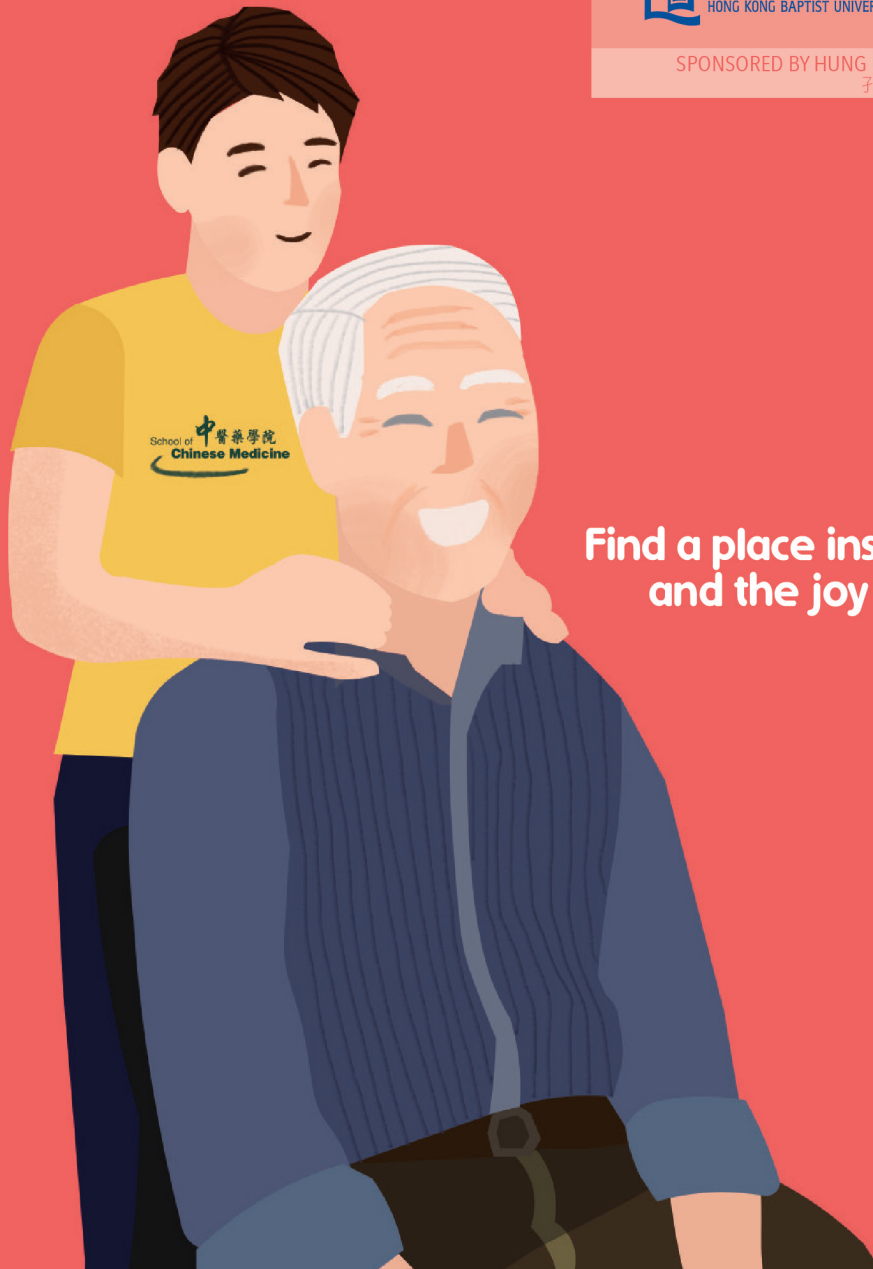

Orthopaedics and Traumatology of Chinese Medicine and Tui Na

This course provides the fundamental theory of orthopaedics and traumatology of Chinese medicine, and the basic clinical knowledge of these diseases and the rules of treatment based on the differentiation of symptoms and signs.

Ancient Medical Art of Healing

The popular use of traditional Chinese medicine for orthopaedic conditions has stood well against the test of time. Students of the course will use their professional knowledge to help relieve the pain symptoms of the elderly living in rural communities in Mainland China. They will also carry out falls risk assessment based on international guidelines and introduce measures to prevent falling among the elderly.
